### **VACANCY FOR A COUNCILLOR**

There is currently a vacancy on the Council and having been through the prescribed procedure, no election has been requested.

The vacancy will therefore now be filled by the co-option process at a meeting of the parish council on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2026.

Should anyone wish to be considered for this vacancy they should apply in writing to the council at the email or address below, by no later than 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2026. Applications should contain a brief personal introduction, the reasons you wish to become a Councillor, and details of the skills and qualities you would bring to the role.

Section 79(1) of the Local Government Act 1972 provides that, unless disqualified, a person is qualified to be co-opted as a local councillor if they are over 18, a qualifying Commonwealth citizen or a qualifying EU citizen or an EU citizen with retained rights on the day of their selection and:

- a. on that day he/she is and thereafter continues to be a local government elector for the area of the authority; or
- b. he/she has during the whole of the twelve months preceding that day occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in that area; or
- c. his/her principal or only place of work during that twelve months has been in that area; or
- d. he/she has during the whole of those twelve months resided in that area; or
- e. he/she has during the whole of those twelve months resided either in the parish or community or within three miles of it.
