VACANCY FOR A COUNCILLOR

There is currently a vacancy on the Council and having been through the prescribed procedure, no election has been requested.

The vacancy will therefore now be filled by the co-option process at a meeting of the parish council on 3rd March 2026.

Should anyone wish to be considered for this vacancy they should apply in writing to the council at the email or address below, by no later than 23rd February 2026. Applications should contain a brief personal introduction, the reasons you wish to become a Councillor, and details of the skills and qualities you would bring to the role.

Section 79(1) of the Local Government Act 1972 provides that, unless disqualified, a person is qualified to be co-opted as a local councillor if they are over 18, a qualifying Commonwealth citizen or a qualifying EU citizen or an EU citizen with retained rights on the day of their selection and:

- a. on that day he/she is and thereafter continues to be a local government elector for the area of the authority; or
- b. he/she has during the whole of the twelve months preceding that day occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in that area; or
- c. his/her principal or only place of work during that twelve months has been in that area; or
- d. he/she has during the whole of those twelve months resided in that area; or
- e. he/she has during the whole of those twelve months resided either in the parish or community or within three miles of it.
